SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS

Keep away from children

Use gloves and safety glasses

Check max construction load of ceiling before placing pouches

In case of leakage – discard pouch and wash your hands and contaminated areas

Do not use damaged or leaking pouches

Keep away from sharp and pointy object

Do not cut to size

INSTALLATION GUIDE

- Make sure there are no electric- UTP or any other cables, wires, pipes, screws, bolts, nuts, nails, any sharp or pointy foreign objects under the pouches
- Don't block air ducts, fans or other ventilation holes and units
- Place pouches in the tile only
- Do not place on the struts
- Do not place items on the pouch
- Use steel or aluminum perforated ceiling tiles for best performance. Always check the surface of the tile: only use pouches on even surfaces
- Place the pouches printed side up for both best performance and aesthetics
- Make sure the pouches are laying perfectly flat on the tile
- Do not attempt to hang items from the ceiling tile that has PCM pouch in it, therefore it's advised to place PCM inside sticker to ceiling corner, when finished placing the pouches
- Please readjust ventilation in plenum to exhaust heat during the day and insert cold air at night to reactivate the HS22 passive climate ceiling. Check with the HVAC installer

To place pouches on a ready ceiling, start by taking out the centre tile or light tile, so you can work-around and place pouches on 8 tiles as shown in the figure.
